









## Protocol for Risk Management and Testing for COVID-19 during the Ski Jumping FIS Summer Grand Prix Shchuchinsk 2021

This Protocol was prepared by the Kazakhstan Ski Association in accordance with the Resolution of the Chief State Sanitary Doctor of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated June 25, 2021 No. 99, the Resolution of the Chief State Sanitary Doctor of Akmola region dated July 31, 2021 No. 5 and the FIS Risk Management and Testing Protocol for COVID-19.

	> FIS Officials
	Broadcasters, Holders, Sponsors and Partners, Event Management, Timing &
	Data Service, Suppliers and etc.
	Local Organising Committee
Prevention	> Health takes the highest priority; a high level of solidarity and individual
	responsibility is required.
	Persons with COVID-19 symptoms must not attend the event.
	➤ If a case of COVID-19 is diagnosed after an event (after a max. of 14 days), the
	LOC must be informed immediately via the COVID-19 Hotline.
	All of the information must be entered truthfully.
FIS passport	Mandatory registration in the FIS C-19 passport.
	➤ The following information must be uploaded to the FIS C-19 passport not be older
	that 72h by the time accreditation is to be picked up:
	<ul> <li>Negative Covid-19 PCR test result including the testing date and the national</li> </ul>
	laboratory certificate
	- "FIS Health Questionnaires"
	Anyone who travels to the event without all of the requisite documentation will not
	be provided with accreditation. This means that they will not be able to gain access
T = = 4:	to the event grounds and must self-isolate before filling out the documents.
Testing	> Upon arrival to the Nur-Sultan, everyone must present a negative Covid-19 PCR
	test that was carried out no more than 72 hours previously.
	After arrival to the hotel, it is necessary to pass the PCR test for COVID-19 in the special medical room, and stay at the hotel room until the test results are received
	<ul> <li>Mandatory to pass PCR test before Event</li> <li>Mandatory Antigen Covid-19 (2019-nCoV (SARS-CoV-2) express testing for all</li> </ul>
	teams and personnel will be arranged at the medical room on the hotel every 48
	hours.
	<ul> <li>Mandatory to pass PCR test before departure.</li> </ul>
	In the event of a positive result being returned by the COVID-19 express test, a
	COVID-19 PCR test must also be carried out to validate the quick-test result.
	➤ LOC may at any time arrange for tests (PCR or Express) to be carried out
	unannounced.
	• If the participant will receive positive test to COVID-19, but have an antibody test
	and proof that the person had been ill not more than 1 month, he may be allowed to
	participate in the competition.
	All costs for additional tests must be paid by themselves.

	➤ We expect that each team member will be pass minimum - 3 PCR test and 1
	Express test during the Event.
Accreditation	> The accreditations must be picked up altogether by the team captain of each team.
	> The accreditation serves as part of our contact tracing system and must be worn
	on your person at all times.
	> The accreditation must in no circumstances whatsoever be given to third parties.
Mask	Everyone must wear a face mask in all areas and accreditation zones on the event
obligation	grounds.
	Masks do not have to be worn in the following exceptional circumstances:
	- By athletes immediately before, during and after the competition
	- During meal times after individuals have sat down at their tables.
	The participants shall be responsible for sourcing masks themselves.
	Used protective masks may only be disposed of in the designated waste containers.
Transport	The Organizing Committee will provide transportation vehicles for each team
•	separately with following routes:
	1. Airport – Venue – Airport
	All vehicles will be disinfected twice a day.
What to do if	> Should you develop symptoms, you must inform the team manager immediately.
you	The affected person must enter self-isolation immediately.
experience	> The team manager shall inform the COVID-19 Coordinator of the LOC
symptoms	immediately via the COVID-19 Hotline.
• •	➤ The COVID-19 Coordinator shall inform the task force.
	➤ The LOC shall consult the National Health authorities and make a decision on the
	next steps to take.
	> Any information provided to third parties (the media, etc.) must be approved by
	the LOC.
